Garden Update - Thank you to those that came out and helped clear and tidy the community garden in April. It was an amazing event, and everyone had a lovely time. We have also added new soil and new planters and our regular gardeners are now cracking on with growing their spices and vegetables.

TMO has also successfully secured £11K CGS grant for landscaping the former "illegal parking zone" towards the rear side of Wrayburn House on Llewellyn Street, to place large plant pots strategically to prevent fly tipping in Llewellyn St and for wildlife to flourish on Bevington St side by building arches to link the raised and toping up the beds with better soil and a Mediterranean herb garden.

Bike Shelter Installation Update – WCO Board recently met and decided we will install a green nontransparent bike shelter using the funding received from Tideway. We are asking all bike users to avoid using the corridors and landings to keep your bikes, as they are not only causing obstructions and H&S issues for residents and visitors, but it attracts vandals and criminals in the block.

2021/22 has been a success: Last year was another challenging year for TMO's across Southwark but in terms of achieving results in key areas of work we are monitored on by Southwark Council, it's been another outstanding year for Wrayburn TMO – we are delighted to report that we have achieved or exceeded all our key targets:

Rent: Income Collection for the year was 101 %+.

Overall improved Cleaning and Gardening: We achieved more than 80% 'excellent' or 'good' results during monthly estate inspections.

78 Repairs were issued during the year, and we met our target of 97% + repairs delivering "first time right" and 97% + "satisfaction" achieved.

We've relet VOIDS within target times.

Achieved targets for tenancy audits and welfare checks on our elderly and vulnerable residents.

Anti- Social Behaviour Complaints: Dealt with all ASB complaints swiftly and within target times.
